

Wednesday Night Alive! has been an integral part of American Lutheran Church of Sun City for over 25 years. The goal of WNA is to combine fellowship with outreach in a way that inspires, educates, entertains and enriches our lives and as well as strengthening our social connections. All WNA programs and meals are open to church members, non-members, and the general community.

The WNA season begins on the first Wednesday in November with a special Gala kickoff program and continues weekly until Holy Week. Each WNA event consists of a program at 4:00 p.m. followed by a dinner in the Fellowship Hall at 5:00 p.m., and then another program (usually a musical performance) at 6:00 p.m. Most programs are held in the Sanctuary. During Advent and Lent, the 6:00 p.m. program is replaced by a church service. Attending the 4:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. programs is free and open to the public. 


Organ recital by ALC's own James Gerber

Join us for dinner

Each week between programs at 5:00 p.m., a tasty and nutritious catered dinner is served in our Fellowship Hall. Each dinner includes an entrée and sides such as a salad and/or vegetable, a dinner roll, dessert, and coffee or tea. Tickets for the dinner must be purchased in advance, by noon the prior Monday. The cost for the dinner is \$12, with some exceptions – the Gala dinner (November 1, 2023) costs \$15; the Mardi Gras pancake dinner (February 7, 2024) costs \$10. The Christmas Potluck (December 13, 2023) and Ash Wednesday Soup dinner (February 14, 2024) are free, although advance reservations are still needed.

Tickets for the dinner may be purchased in person at the WNA table before the Saturday evening service, between Sunday services, or in the church office on Thursdays, Fridays, and Mondays (before noon). Cash or checks are the only form of payment accepted when purchasing tickets in person. Tickets may also be purchased online on the alcsuncity.org website with a credit card – the cutoff for web purchases is the previous Sunday night at midnight. Please note: cash or checks are accepted when purchasing tickets in person; a credit card is necessary for purchase online.

Telephone reservations are not accepted and walk-ins for the dinner cannot be accommodated.
